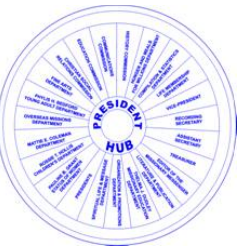

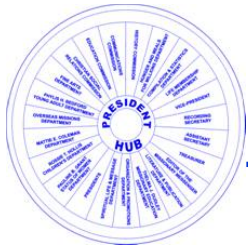
"Our Stars"

- Loves basketball

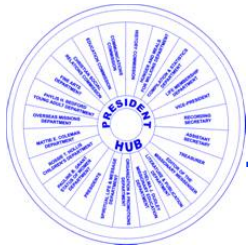
Elijah

- Likes football



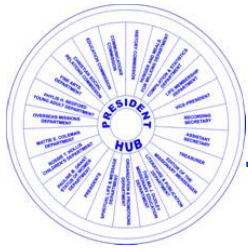
A Closer Look at "Our Stars"

- Church Growth

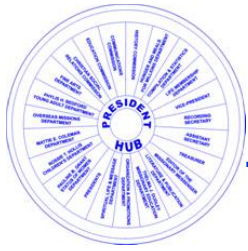


"This Is What We Want to Say"

- Simple

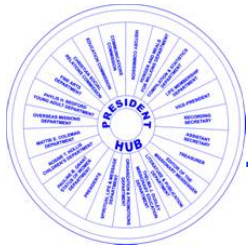


"Enemy's Camp"

Satan get under my feet

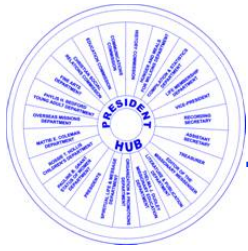
